**This net meets each Thursday evening on the 145.115 repeater courtesy of the Northern Colorado Amateur Radio Club. All stations with 2-meter privileges are invited to check-in.**

**Stations with information about local Amateur Radio activities, or clubs with announcements of activities and meetings are invited to check-in.**

**This is a directed net and all traffic will go through the Net Control Station.**

**This is (Your Call), my name is (Your Name) and I am located in (Your City). I will be your Net Control Station for this session of the net. Is there any emergency or priority traffic before we begin?**

*(Handle any Emergency Traffic immediately, or whenever it is presented, during the net.)*

**Is there any formal NTS traffic for the net?**

**When checking in to the net please give your call phonetically, your name, your location, and indicate if you have any announcements or training for the net.**

*(Acknowledge all check-ins.)*

*(When acknowledging check-ins **with** traffic, acknowledge their call and that they have traffic.)*

**I will first take check-ins from those stations on battery or emergency power by call suffixes.**
