The purpose of the Tech Net is to enlighten amateur radio operators on topics of a technical nature. We will do our best to answer any technical questions to benefit all listening. If a subject has never been clear to you, this is an excellent opportunity to find an answer. If anyone feels they have information that will help regarding that subject, please give your call sign, and net control will call on you.

This net may be interrupted at any time for emergencies or priority traffic. If you need to use the system for an emergency during the net, say “break” and give your call sign. We will acknowledge you and suspend the net until you advise that you are clear. Is there any emergency or priority traffic at this time?

All licensed amateur radio operators with 70cm privileges are encouraged to check in to the net. Club membership is encouraged but never required for participation within the net. Check-ins are requested to count participation, and no check-out is required. This is “YOUR CALL SIGN”, net control for tonight’s NCARC Tech Net.

When checking in, please give your call sign slowly, first alphabetically, then again using the ITU phonetic alphabet, along with your name and location. When checking in, please state if you have a topic, you would like to discuss. I will be taking Check-ins in groups of 3. When I have acknowledged the first group of 3, I will move on to the next group of 3.

I will start by taking check-ins from call suffixes Alpha through Mike. Alpha through Mike, please call now.

Any other check-ins from call suffixes Alpha through Mike?

Hearing none, I will now take check-ins in groups of 3 from call suffixes November through Zulu. November through Zulu, please call now.

Any other check-ins from call suffixes November through Zulu?

***{Call on those that indicated they have a topic to discuss}***

Okay, let’s begin with ***(call sign), (name);*** what is your topic for the net tonight?

Does anyone have any additional to add to this topic?
