Horsetooth

The new 447.275 repeater that was placed several weeks ago is operating very well. The improved power is noticeably better. The new 60 gHz links have been received, programmed, labeled and will be placed up there soon. Currently, our access is unavailable due to the NTSB investigation of the plane crash. We'll get there as soon as we are able!

Buckhorn

All of the link radios at Buckhorn have been converted to fiber optic cable. The dropouts, latencies and interruptions we've seen from the FM broadcasters are now gone! This site is in great shape now.

There are some site visits that I want to complete before snow sets in, but the phone patch project should get moving along towards finishing up soon after.

UNC

We've been given a new location to mount and house our gear on the roof of the McKee building. We are currently investigating what would be needed to do that and hope to have things ironed out there soon. This will improve our microwave link, and will restore backup connectivity to the WeldEOC location for emergency support.

Red Feather

Negotiations continue and we'll keep you updated as news develops!

Rattlesnake

We will have one trip at least to Rattlesnake to install a new battery bank before winter. There are hopes of getting the receiver hotel installed there soon, but it's unknown if this will happen yet this year or not.

The 447.750 will soon be receiving a new antenna combination system to improve its performance. It's also going to have a new backup battery system installed at the same time that will give it emergency power capabilities. Stay tuned for its return soon!

On a side note

NCARC is continuing to work collaboratively with area clubs and they have recently made great progress in securing some new sites to continue coverage.

We've been speaking about continuing our coverage over the Cheyenne ridge to the East. We got to Grover and were still negotiating site space in Sterling. This is all resolved due to a relationship RMHAM has developed. With a little luck from the weather, new linked repeaters (Colorado Connection and RMHAM DMR) will come up on the network in Sterling, and Brush!

Although not linked to any NCARC repeaters, this coverage will greatly increase the footprint to the East and all systems are open to any licensed ham.
