
We are going to start linking the 146.850 Greeley repeater to the 447.275 for our weekly nets to improve access for those located in the southern end of Greeley. This link will be on during nets only for now and we will evaluate as we move forward.

Buckhorn

You may have heard the 447.700 or 146.625 sending lots of CW saying "OFLN" and "OK" and going on and off the air. We have an issue with the GPS receiver there losing its lock and it's required for those repeaters. I am investigating a replacement for that site and should have something there soon to fix this issue!

CSU-VARA

Although not an official NCARC site, in collaboration with NCARC the CSUARC has placed (with many thanks to WOBNC for the hardware donation) a VARA FM Winlink node at CSU. It's been operational for a few weeks. It's currently using Bob's callsign, WOBNC, but will switch soon to WOQEY-10 (the CSU club callsign). The computer will be replaced shortly as well with a fanless one that should survive the summers up there better. When that happens, the node will also become capable of 1200 baud Winlink (IE, it will answer to 1200 or VARA FM on the same frequency). Watch for another announcement when that switch is made, but for now, feel free to use the VARA node with the WOBNC callsign!
